Please refer to CR's letter No.C.659/RD/Container/CRT dt.03.06.2011 enclosing a copy of CR's earlier letter of even number dt.30.03.2011 seeking clarification whether Terminal Access Charge will be collected for movement of empty rakes or not.

The matter has been examined and it is clarified that Terminal Access Charge is leviable for dealing with container trains at railway owned terminals (notified as Container Rail Terminals), irrespective of the fact whether it is loaded with containers or otherwise.
