

Sub: Issue of tickets against Military Warrants

A copy of M/o Defence letter No.12692/GC/Mov C dt.19.09.2012 forwarding a copy of "Revised Travel Entitlements(6thCPC):Armed Forces Personnel effective from 01 Sep 2008" is enclosed herewith.

Vide above mentioned letter, Defence authority has complained about non-issue of tickets to Defence personnel as per the entitlement indicated in Military Warrants. They have mentioned that with the grant of higher grade pay under ACP scheme, a Defence person becomes eligible to travel in higher class. Military Warrants are issued as per entitlement after due verification by competent authority. In any case, the cost of warrants is reimbursed to Railways. Therefore, tickets may be issued as per the entitlement indicated in Military Warrants.

In view of above, all concerned may please be advised to issue ticket as per the entitlement indicated in the Military Warrant.



**RAIL TICKETS TO SERVICE PERS TRAVELLING
ON WARRANT/FORMS**

1. This pertains to issue of rail ticket to service pers travelling on warrant/forms.
2. As you may be aware, all travel entitlements of service pers which were rank based earlier, post 6th CPC, are based now on Grade Pay. Service pers, who do not get regular promotion, are eligible for grant of promotion under Assured Career Progression Scheme, which is also applicable to civilian Govt servants. By virtue of this service pers are granted higher Grade Pay in the same rank and consequently become eligible for higher travel entitlement attached to the revised Grade Pay i.e. Hav on grant of 1st ACP are entitled to AC-II instead of AC-III as their Grade Pay is raised from Rs.2800/- to Rs. 3400/-. Details of the entitlement of service pers vis-à-vis Grade Pay is given in the enclosed chart.
3. It has been reported that Rly authorities in some cases are refusing to allow them travel in higher class which otherwise is entitled to them due to higher Grade Pay under ACP Scheme. The warrant for the entitled class, which is indicated on the warrant form, is issued for a higher class by the unit after due verification of the entitlement of the service pers with reference to Grade Pay drawn by him. In any case, the cost of warrant is being re-imbursed by the Defence to Railways in full and as such any objection by the Rlys needs to be justified.
4. In view of the above, you are requested to issue suitable instructions to all Zonal offices to issue ticket even in higher class if indicated in the warrant/ form to obviate the difficulty faced by Defence commuters in this regard.
5. An early action will be highly appropriate.
