

Sub : Classification of Secondary Nutrient/Soil Conditioner (CMS).  
Ref : N.W.Rly L. No. C-70/1 dated 31.12.2013 and 24.02.2014.

Reference is invited to North Western Railways' letter cited above regarding classification of Secondary Nutrient / Soil Conditioner (CMS).

The matter has been examined in consultation with Traffic Transportation Directorate, Railway Board. It is advised that Secondary Nutrient/Soil Conditioner (CMS) may be charged as per the instructions contained in Para 1.4 of Rates Circular No. 06 of 2008, duly re-iterated as Para 3.0 of the guidelines contained in the Appendix to IRCA Goods Tariff No. 47, Part-I (Vol-II).

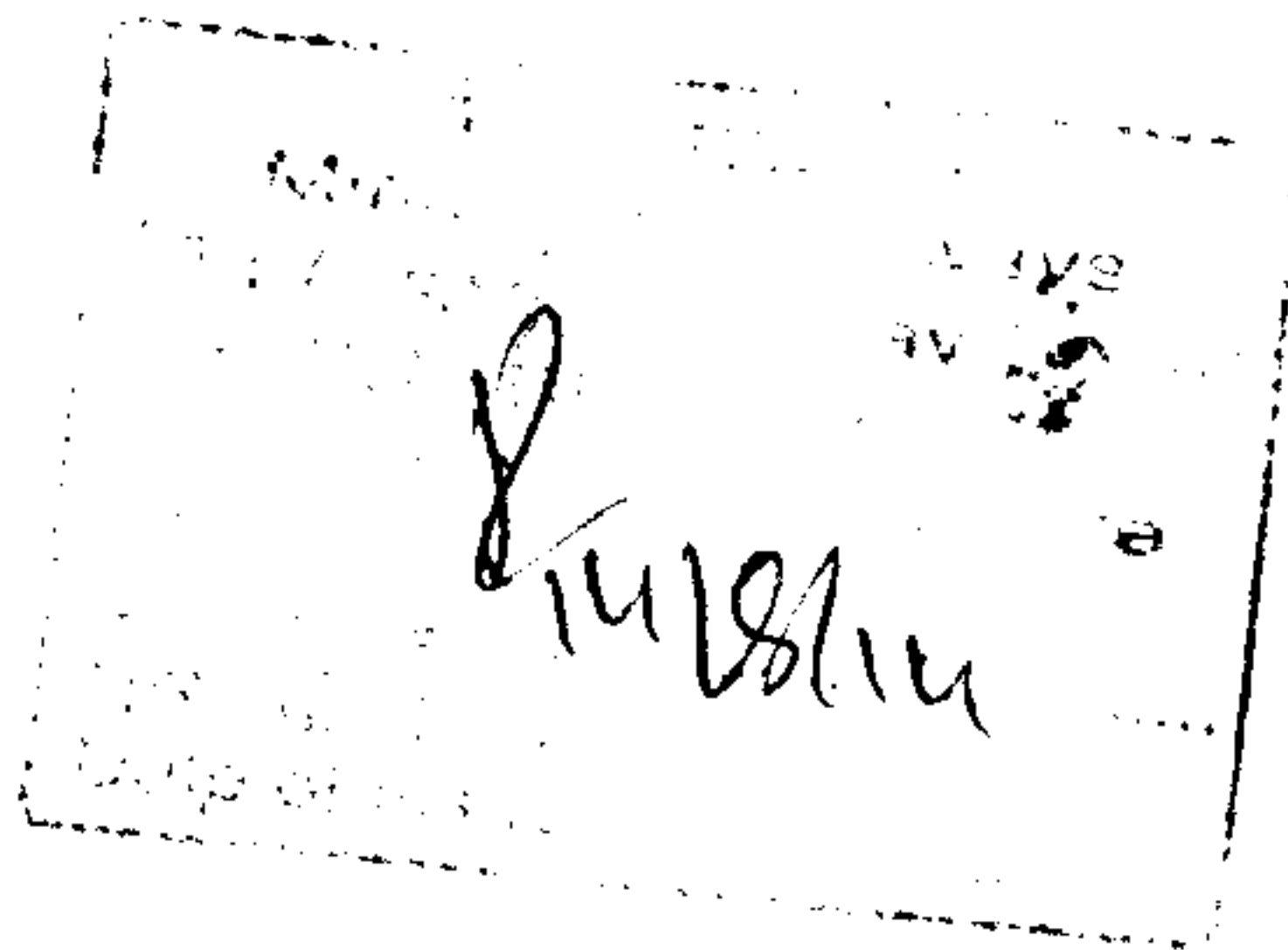
However, Railway may advise the party to approach Department of Agriculture and Co-operation, Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development for inclusion of Secondary Nutrient / Soil Conditioner (CMS), *per se*, in the Fertiliser Control Order, 1985, so that this commodity can avail the benefit of charging under "Chemical Manures" at Class-130.
