Sub:- Weightage for night duty.

....

Under the existing orders, only the categories specified in the Appendix to Board's letter No.PC 60/H.2/3 dated 7.7.1962 (and as amplified from time to time), are eligible for being granted the weightage for night duty, subject further to the following conditions:-

- (a) in respect of the categories governed by the Hours of Employment Regulations, the staff should have been classified as 'continuous' or 'Intensive', and
- (b) where certain yard-sticks have been prescribed, those have to be fulfilled before qualifying for the grant of weightage.

ys. 2. Representations have been received for enlarging the scope of the existing list of staff eligible for the grant of weightage as also for the relaxation/waival of the yardsticks prescribed in certain cases. These have been considered very carefully by the Board. In supersession of all previous orders on the matter, the Board have decided that:

- (i) all class III and class IV staff including workshop staff, drawing pay upto Rs.470 (A.S.), but excluding those who are classified as "essentially intermittent" and "excluded" under the Hours of Employment Regulations, should be granted weightage for night duty;
- (ii) night duty for this purpose shall mean all duty performed between 22 and 6 hours; and
- (iii) the rates of night duty allowance shall be related to the basic pay (substantive or officiating) instead of pay plus Dearness Allowance as
