concessional vouchers.

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

3. A copy of Board's O.M. of even no. dated 16.12.1997 addressed to Ministry of Defence is enclosed. The cost of concession given to Defence personnel while issuing tickets in exchange of Warrants/Vouchers and concessional vouchers borne by Railways will henceforth be debited to the Ministry of Defence. The existing system of issuing tickets in exchange of warrants/forms will be continued till further notice.

4. Necessary instructions may please be issued to all concerned and acknowledge receipt.


