

Sub: No Stabling Charge in case of container traffic
Ref: Board's letter No.TC-I/2019/201/6 dt.03.08.2020

Please refer to Board's letter under reference vide which it has been decided that no Stabling Charge will be levied in case of container traffic from 18.05.2020 to 31.10.2020. Post which, normal guidelines will be applicable.

The matter has been reviewed. In partial modification of the aforesaid letter, the competent authority has decided to extend the guidelines regarding non levy of Stabling Charge in case of container traffic beyond 31.10.2020 till 31.03.2021. Post which, normal guidelines will be applicable.

This issues in consultation with Traffic Transportation Directorate and with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
