**Sub : Electronic payment system(EPS) for small customers dealing
on Goods shed.**

Railways have suggested that small customers loading/unloading at goods sheds should also be permitted for making Electronic payment subject to the condition that they will neither be required to enter in to tripartite agreement with Railways & Bank nor furnish any Letter of Credit(LC)/Bank Gurarantee(BG). Only the Bank Challan issued for transfer of funds in Railway account may be accepted and Paid RR may be issued.

The matter has been examined and it has been decided that the above proposal has **not** been agreed to. Such small customers can continue to make payment through Demand Drafts or alternatively, they can come on to the existing system of E-payment.
