3. In terms of Rule 201(13) of Goods Tariff Part I, Volume I, Change of Commodity is not permitted in a registration already made.

4. Requests for change of commodity in a registration already made can be considered and Divisional Officers, i.e. Senior DCS/DCS may be authorised to permit a change in the commodity indicated in the original registration as long as it is in the same priority group.
