After his tour to NCR, MT has desired that Zonal Railways should install Notes Counting - cum - Fake Currency detecting machines at large booking/PRS offices wherever they find the need & justification (.) In this connection attention is invited to Board's letter/telex of even number dated 30.10.2000, 20.3.02 & 19.4.02 wherein the guidelines for procurement of Fake Currency Detection Machines & Currency Counting Machines were issued and Zonal Railways were asked to procure & install them at Reservation Offices, PRS Terminals, Goods Booking Offices, etc. where cash is transacted in large amount, after making assessment of their need (.) Board desire that action may be taken for procurement & installation of these machines at major stations/ reservation offices having heavy cash transactions, subject to assessment of need (.)
