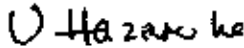

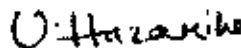

Subj: Grant of rail warrant facilities to the
staff of S.S.B. Directorate, Cabinet
Secretariat (Department of Cabinet Affairs)
for rail journeys on official duties.

The Railway Board have agreed to allow the use of
Railway Warrant facility to the security personnel of the
S.S.B. Directorate, Cabinet Secretariat (Department of
Cabinet Affairs) as at present admissible to the Police
officials upto the rank of Inspectors. The existing Police
Warrant form may be used with suitable modification.

The charges for the journeys will be leviable at
the public tariff rates and the usual commission charges
should also be recovered in addition.

The debit in respect of the bills for expenditure
in this regard may be raised against Personal Ledger Account
of the Director of Accounts, Cabinet Secretariat, Level V,
Block 5, East Block, R.K. Puram, New Delhi-22.
