**Sub:-** Serving of packaged drinking water in sealed disposable glasses along with standard casserole meals.

In continuation to Commercial Circular No. 33 of 2003.(2003/TG.III/631/3 dt. 30.4.2003), following modification is issued with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.:

**Packaged drinking Water:** It has now been approved by the Board in concurrence of the Finance Dte. that 250 ml. packaged drinking water in sealed glasses may be served to the passengers along with the casserole meals. The price of standard casserole meals has been kept unchanged, subject to strict adherence of instructions that sealed disposable glass is used and penal action is taken against contractors who have been caught flouting the instructions by supplying water pouches.
