Reference Ministry of Railways' letter of even number dated 28.03.2005 regarding grant of 50% concession in second class to Kisans and Milk producers for travel to Institutes of National Level for training/learning better agricultural practices and dairy farming, subject to certain conditions (.) As announced by MR on 24.2.06 in his Budget Speech for 2006-07, Ministry of Railways have decided that the above mentioned Kisans and Milk producers will be granted 50% concession in sleeper class Mail/Express fares also, subject to same conditions (.) These instructions for grant of concession in sleeper class will come into effect on tickets issued from 01.4.2006 (.) Necessary changes may be made in the software of PRS, SPTMs & UTS (.) Action may be taken to make changes in passenger information systems at all places including enquiry systems, websites, etc. (.) Wide publicity through various media may be given at regular intervals (.) Necessary instructions may be issued to all concerned immediately and implementation ensured (.) 
