Sub: Minimum licence fee for Refreshment Rooms, Stalls and Trolleys at "D", "E" & "F" category stations.

In partial modification of para 2 of Board's Commercial Circular number 70 of 2006 (No.2005/TG-III/600/41 dated 11.8.2006), it is hereby advised that the DRMs with the concurrence of the Divisional Finance concerned should fix minimum licence fee for Refreshment Rooms, Stalls and Trolleys at "D", "E", and "F" category stations based on rational factors like, the State GDP, purchasing power, land value, type of clientele, number of passengers, location of units, sales turnover etc.
