

SUB: Dynamic Pricing Policy – Premium Service Surcharge.

Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to levy of Premium Service Surcharge of 20%( Twenty Percent) on movement of Perishable goods booked under Goods Tariff subject to following conditions.

- (a) List of perishable goods shall consist of Mango, Banana, Orange and Chikoo loaded in Premium Goods Trains. Running of these trains is monitored by the Emergency Cell of the Coaching Dte of Railway Board.
- (b) 20% (Twenty Percent) Premium Service Surcharge will be levied on movement of aforementioned traffic when moved in goods wagons.
- (c) This Premium Service Surcharge of 20%( Twenty Percent) will be levied on the Normal Tariff Rate. ( Base Freight rate as per Goods Tariff plus Busy season Surcharge if any).
- (d) These instructions will come into force w.e.f. 15.5.2006.
