Sub: Levy of Development Surcharge and Terminal Charge.

1. Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to the levy of Development Surcharge on Goods Traffic which will be 2% (Two percent) of Normal Tariff Rates (NTR).
2. Sanction of the Central Government is also accorded to the levy of Terminal Charge of Rs.10 (Rupees ten) per tonne per terminal. These Terminal Charges will be levied for Bulk and Loose traffic on Railway-owned terminals and sidings and not on terminals owned by customers. The same will be collected at the time of issue of RR itself. These charges will be leviable on loading and unloading terminals independently and separately on the basis of chargeable weight at the time of issue of RR. Figures of any subsequent weightment shall not be reckoned for levy of terminal charge.

Illustration: Say, a customer books 3600 tonnes of coal from a private siding to a goods shed. Charges amounting to Rs.36,000/- (Rs.10 x 3600t) will be charged as Terminal Charge (goods shed). Now, if the same traffic is to be moved between two goods shed, Rs.36,000/- will be levied as terminal charge for each terminal. Thus, customer will have to pay a total of Rs.72,000/- (Rs.36,000 x 2) as terminal charges. However, if the traffic moves between two private sidings, no terminal charge will be levied.

3. These instructions will come into force with effect from 01.07.2007.
4. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
