Sub: Adjustments in classification of commodities

1.0 The Central Government has decided to make the following adjustment in the classification of certain commodities as mentioned in General Classification of Goods in the IRCA Goods Tariff No.44 Pt.I (Vol.II):

S.No.	Commodity	Existing Class	Revised Class	Main Commodity Head
1	All commodities under the Main Commodity Head "Limestone & Dolomite"	140	160	Limestone & Dolomite
2	Iron Ore booked to ports	160	180	Ores
3	Foodgrains Non-PDS	120	110	Foodgrains & Pulses
4	Foodgrains for PDS/PAP	100	110	Foodgrains & Pulses
5	Wheat Flour	90	110	Flours
6	Chemical Manures	100	110	Chemical Manures

2.0 Accordingly, following amendments may be done in IRCA Goods Tariff No.44 Pt.I (Vol.II):

- (i) Limestone & Dolomite - The classification of Main Commodity Head "Limestone & Dolomite" at S.No.45 shall be revised from Class 140 to Class 160.
- (ii) Iron Ore booked to Ports - Insert the following note below the Main Commodity Head "Ores" at S.No.59:

"Note:- Iron Ore booked to Ports shall be charged at Class 180."
- (iii) Foodgrains - The classification of Main Commodity Head "Foodgrains & Pulses" at S.No.30 shall be revised from Class 120 to Class 110.

Delete the following note appearing below S.No.30:

"Note:- *Foodgrains for Public Distribution System (PDS) or Poverty Alleviation Programme (PAP) shall be charged at Class-100."

Also, insert the following note below S.No.30:

"Note:- All pulses shall be charged at Class 120."

- (iv) Wheat Flour - Insert the following below the Main Commodity Head "Flours" at S.No.28:

"Note: Wheat flour shall be charged at Class 110."

- (v) Chemical Manures - The classification of Main Commodity Head "Chemical Manures" at S.No.17 shall be revised from Class 100 to Class 110.

- 3.0 This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate in the Ministry of Railways.
- 4.0 This instruction will come into force with effect from 01.12.2005.
