Sub: Booking and carriage of Silver anklets/leg chains/silver jewellery/ silver handicrafts in passenger compartment as personal luggage

The request made by the Salem Silver Leg Chains Manufacturer Association, Salem for grant of permission for booking and carriage of silver anklets/leg chains/silver jewellery silver/handicrafts as personal luggage in passenger compartments with owners has been examined in Board's office. It has been decided that booking and carriage of anklets/leg chains/silver jewellery/handicrafts may be allowed to be carried in the passenger compartment with owners as personal luggage only in upper classes on payment of usual charges for such carriage without any free allowance and fulfillment of terms & conditions laid down in Rule 801 of in IRCA Coaching Tariff No.25, Part-I(Vol.-III). Permission for such carriage will be subject to following limits:

<u>CLASS</u>	<u>MAXIMUM LIMIT</u>
AC FIRST Class	70 Kgs
AC 2- TIER/1 st Class	50 Kgs
AC 3 -TIER/AC Chair Car	40 Kgs

These items can be carried in brief cases of maximum dimension of 40 cms X 35 cms X15 cms in personal custody.
