Sub : Charging of excess weight of luggage/parcels detected at the destination station.

Ref : Board's letter Nos. TCII/2046/04/3 dated 24.08.04 and 21.9.04.

The issue regarding charging of excess weight of luggage/parcels with passengers detected at the destination station due to fault of weighing machines at the originating station has been examined in Board's office. It has been decided that punitive charges may be collected at six times the traffic rates at Scale-R only on unbooked excess luggage with passenger. Otherwise normal charges may be levied on booked luggage/parcels detected excess over first weighment at originating station.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
