SUB: Revision in the classification of Kerosene Oil.

Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to revise the classification of Kerosene Oil from Class-130 (Trainload) to Class-150 (Trainload).

2. Accordingly, amendment may be done in IRCA Goods Tariff No.44 Pt. I (Vol.II).

(i)Kerosene Oil – The classification of Main Commodity Head “Kerosene Oil” at S.No.43 shall be revised from Class-130 to Class-150.

3. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate in the Ministry of Railways.

4. The instruction will come into force with effect from 15.01.2006.
