SUB: Revision in the classification of Salt for Human Consumption.

Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to revise the classification of Salt for human consumption from Class-90 to Class-100.

2. Accordingly, amendment may be done in IRCA Goods Tariff No.44 Pt. I (Vol.II).

(i) Salt for human consumption – The classification of Main Commodity Head “Salt (for human consumption)” at S.No.66 shall be revised from Class-90 to Class-100.

3. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate in the Ministry of Railways.

4. The instruction will come into force with effect from 15.01.2006.
