1.1	There should be stress on the quality of training imparted to the staff at the ZRTIs. The feedback on quality of training for guards, section controllers, ALP leaves considerable scope for improvement.	AII COMS CCMS ED (T&MPP)
1.2	Use of Information technology in training at the ZRTIs is very low. Training must include coverage of all the IT systems implemented on IR. There should be at least one paper on IT in the ZRTIs.	AII COMs CAO/FOIS MD/CRIS
1.3	Responsibility of the Station Managers is changing. They should be taught station management, contract management, passenger amenities etc at the ZRTIs. With increase in outsourcing of services, many of the staff are facing vigilance cases because of lack of knowledge and poor implementation of the rules and procedures. Case studies on the vigilance cases can be taught to the staff in a contract management course at the ZRTIs.	All COMS CCMS
1.4	Principals ZTRIs informed that the paper setting in the ZTRIs is through a manual mechanism. At present, 40% of the questions are objective in nature. 4.1	A presentation on the Safety Information Management System (SIMS) - http://sims.railnet.gov.in was given to the Principal ZRTIs.	
4.2	SIMS has details of all the accidents reported by Zonał Railways and this should form the basis of the course contents in the ZRTIs. Each ZRTIs was asked to take the user ID and Password in accessing the accident data from ED(Safety) I.	ED/Safety-I
4.3	Adv/Safety stressed on the fact that the accidents on Indian Railways are reducing. As the number of accidents on IR reduces, the capacity to deal with the accidents will also reduce. This calls for sharing and managing the knowledge on the accidents so that the institutional capacity to deal with accidents is sustained.	All COMs
4.4	The content of the course in the ZRTIs is out dated and same should be upgraded in line with the technology upgradation of IRs.	ED(T&MPP) DPM DTT/POL

5. Issues raised by ZRTIs:

ZRTI - (SINI/SER)

	The ZRTI is not having electricity supply for up to 25 days in a month. The generator set provided is not exclusive for the ZRTI	COM/SER
	and this causes serious interruptions in managing the ZRTI.	

ZRTI - TPJ/SR

5	5.2	The honorarium for Yoga Instructors is Rs.75/- per hour. This is grossly inadequate to attract Yoga instructors to impart the courses which are mandatory for the safety category. This should be enhanced.	ED(T&MPP)
5	5.3	To attract quality trainers to the ZRTIs, Principal ZRTI/TPJ suggested increasing the incentive for instructors from 15% to 20%.	ED(T&MPP)

ZRTI – Chandausi/NR

5.4	There is a shortage of IT infrastructure at the ZRTI. No infrastructure is available for taking classes on information technology subjects.	COM/NR
5.5	There is no connectivity of ICMS, CMS or COA at the ZRTI.	COM/NR CAO/FOIS

ZRTI - MZP/ECR

5.6	There is a serious problem of hostel accommodation. The requirement is for 350 staff while the capacity is only for 200 staff. There are no terminals for the IT systems at the ZRTI.	COM/ECR
5.7	ZRTI suggested that a safety oath should be started for the staff when they attend the first introductory course after recruitment. This will imbibe a sense of responsibility in the fresh recruits.	ED(T&MPP)

ZRTI – BSL/CR

5.8	ZRTI/BSL requested for the operating manuals and GRs should be printed in diglot format. There is ambiguity between Hindi and English versions of GRs. This should be resolved.	ADV/SAFETY
5.9	Some of the zonal railways have reduced the period of training for the traffic apprentice from two to one year. However, there are no instructions from Railway Board to this effect.	ED(T&MPP)

5.10	The staff appointed on compassionate appointment quota to Traffic Apprentice/Station Masters should be required to undergo psycho tests on similar lines as for other recruits.	ED (T&MPP)
5.11	The refresher courses for mail express drivers at the ZRTIs can be reduced by 15 days.	EDME (TR)
5.12	Minimum marks required for passing for ASM category is 60%. However, the requirement is prescribed at 60% for traffic and 50% for commercial subjects. There is no clarity on passing a candidate where he/she has passed in both traffic and commercial but has an aggregate of less than 60% marks.	ED(T&MPP)
5.13	Rs.10 crores as the cost of training is due from Konkan Railway Corporation. This should be recovered at the earliest.	ED/P\$U

ZRTI – BHULI/ER

5.1	The court case of the mess Committee staff is pending since long. Early finalization of the case was sought.	COM/ER

ZRTI - APDJ/NFR

5.15	Principal ZRTI/APDJ raised the issue of shortage of funds and even basic computer hardware like PCs cannot be purchased.	COM/NFR ED(T&MPP)
5.16	The honorarium for Yoga Teachers is very less and it should be increased from the present Rs.75/- per hour.	ED (T&MPP)
5.17	There is delay in the evaluation of answer sheets by the officers. MT took serious note of the delay and zonal railways should ensure that no delay in publication of results is attributed to this account.	ALL COMS

ZRTI – UDZ/NWR

5.18	Principal/ZRTI/UDZ suggested that a sandwich course should be introduced for newly recruited ASMs so that they are given exposure to field working in between two theoretical inputs.	DTT/POL
5.19	The quality of instructors is a cause of concern as zonal railways like WR are not forwarding the applications of willing candidates to the ZRTI.	COM/WR COM/NWR
5.20	MT suggested that the vacancy notices of instructions of ZRTIs should be posted on the railnet site of the zonal railways so that those interested can apply directly. If selected, COMs can then be approached to have them relieved.	ALL COMs

5.21	The present age limit for posting as a trainer in a ZRTI is 52 years. This should be increased to 55 years.	ED (T&MPP)
5.22	The Ticket Checking staff is the nodal officer in case of Disaster Management. However, they aren't imparted disaster management training at the ZRTIs.	EDPM ADV/SAFETY

ZRTI - MAULA ALI/SCR

5.23	Principal/ZRTI should be delegated the financial powers for sanctioning and outsourcing development of animated presentation/videos for use as teaching aid in the ZRTIs. Principal informed that a simulator for SMs is under development at Maula Ali.	ED (T&MPP) COM/SCR
5.24	No UTS training is imparted to the ECRCs. However, at some stations UTS/PRS terminal are being operated by ECRCs.	EDPM
5.25	The present duration of customer care training for ticket checking staff is inadequate. This should be increased.	EDPM
