

(i) Container Terminals of other CTOs  
(ii) Private Sidings**

Please refer to Railway Board's letter no. 2009/TT-III/73/9 dated 19.03.2021-  
Container Train Circular No. 04/2021 –Para 4.1 may be read as under:

Existing Para	Revised Para
Para 4.1: CTO can access any private siding after obtaining co-user permission from the owner of the private siding in accordance with Circular No. 2016/TC(FM)/18/20/pt dated 18.08.2020. According to this circular, co-user permission can be obtained on receipt of request from siding owner, with the approval of PCOM, subject to operational feasibility and local constraints.	Para 4.1: CTO can access any private siding after obtaining co-user permission from the owner of the private siding in accordance with Circular No. 2020/TC(FM)/18/20/pt dated 11.08.2021. According to this circular the provision of grant of co-user permission by Railway has been removed, and now siding-owner(s) can permit co-users on their own and can just inform Railway at least 7 working days in advance.
