

GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS

INVITES REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATION FOR REDEVELOPMENT OF NEW DELHI RAILWAY STATION

(RFQ No. 2008/LMB/22/25/RFQ/NDLS Dated 27.10.2008)

- The Ministry of Railways ("MOR"), Government of India plans to redevelop the New Delhi Railway Station through Public Private Partnership (PPP) to provide world-class facilities for railway passengers. The work would encompass redevelopment and modernization of the infrastructure at the passenger terminal, presently handling 0.25 to 0.35 million passengers a day, and would include real-estate development on about 86 hectares of land comprising the railway station, offices, parking, public spaces and commercial development. The concessionaire to be selected through international competitive bidding would undertake the work on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer ("DBFOT") Basis.
- MOR intends to pre-qualify and short-list suitable Applicants in accordance with the procedure set out in the Request for Qualification (RFQ) document.
- The President of India, acting through Executive Director, Land & Amenities-II, Railway Board, having discharged the earlier RFQ no. 2006/LMB/14/51/RFQ/NDLS Dated 30.10.2007,

- now re-invites applications for this purpose from interested parties.
- The new RFQ document dated 27.10.2008 can be down loaded from the website (www.indianrailways.gov.in) or obtained from Room No. 160, Rail Bhawan, New Delhi between 11:00 hrs and 16:00 hrs on all working days on payment of a fee of Rs. 10,00,000 (Rupees ten lakh only) in the form of a demand draft drawn on any Scheduled Bank in India in favour of FA & CAO, Northern Railway and payable at New Delhi.
- A Pre-Application conference will be held on November 20, 2008 at 1100 hrs at the Conference Hall at 2nd Floor, Rail Bhawan, New Delhi.
- The Applications on prescribed form of RFQ should be submitted at the place described in the RFQ documents on or before 15.00 hrs. of December 10, 2008.
